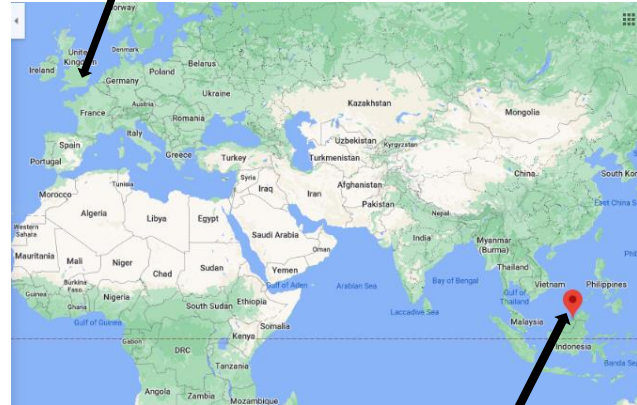


How does the geography of Kampong Ayer compare with the geography of where I live?

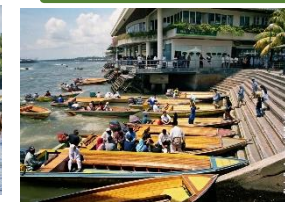
What should I already know?

- Kampong Ayer is a group stilt village built on the Brunei River.
- Water taxis are a popular way to travel!
- There are even schools on stilts!

Key vocabulary and definitions:

<i>capital</i>	A city where a regions government is located
<i>environmental interaction</i>	Interactions between humans and the environment. Ecosystems.
<i>distribution</i>	Sharing of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water.
<i>location</i>	A particular point or place in physical space.
<i>settlement</i>	Any place where people live and form communities.
<i>population</i>	The number of people living in a certain place
<i>hemisphere</i>	A half of the earth, usually as divided into northern and southern halves by the equator
